HIGHWAY SETBACK DISTANCES

For All Zoning Districts

Setback distance = minimum distance from centerline

Class A Highways (State Trunk Highways): setback distance 75 feet except in platted subdivisions where the setback distance shall be 50 feet from the right-of-way lines or 110 feet from the centerline whichever is great, as shown on the recorded plat

Class B Highways (County Trunk Highways): setback distance 75 feet

Class C Highways (Town Roads): setback distance 60 feet except in platted subdivisions where the setback distance shall be 30 feet from the right-of-way lines, as shown on the recorded plat
