Hours of operation: **Saturday 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM year round**

****Additional summer hours: Wednesday 4:00 PM to 8:00 PM Memorial Day-Labor Day**

Hang Tag owners: All garbage must be separated from the recyclable materials and placed in any size/color (**no black**) plastic bags; recyclables in clear plastic bags, bins, or totes – if clear plastic bags are used, they need to be dumped out with bags then placed in garbage compactor. To gain entrance to the Compactor Site, **valid Hang Tags must be made visible for Attendants to view in order to enter the facility.**

Town of Lima clear bags are sold at the site. All bags are 33 gallon plastic bags. Clear bags cost \$40 for 100 bags/case. Payment by check only - made payable to the Town of Lima. No cash payments accepted.

Hang tag disposal permits expire on August 1 each year. Original Hang Tags and annual renewal stickers can be obtained by **mailing a check for \$200 payable to the Town of Lima** along with a self-addressed stamped envelope to PO Box 225, Waldo, WI 53093-0225. Recyclable materials include the items listed -prepared as follows:

Mixed together in a clear plastic bag, bin, or tote. Plastic bag, if used, needs to be emptied then placed in garbage compactor:

- Glass: Food & beverage/Bottles & jars – empty, rinse, caps/labels removed
- Bi-metal “tin” cans/Aluminum cans – empty, rinse
- Plastics #1 thru #5: Plastic household bottles, jars & Jugs/Dairy containers/Produce, bakery & deli containers – empty, rinse & replace caps/lids

Mixed together in a paper grocery bag, bin, tote, or clear plastic bag. Plastic bag, if used, needs to be emptied then placed in garbage compactor:

- Newspapers, inserts, magazines
- Milk, juice & soup cartons
- Office paper, school paper & books
- Cardboard/paperboard (broken down)

Non-Recyclable materials: Plastic bags, newspaper bags, food storage bags, produce bags, bread bags, dry cleaning bags, bubble wrap, product overwrap, plastic case wrap or film, plastic mailers, motor oil bottles, styrofoam, wax or plastic coated cups, paper cups, shredded paper, tissue paper, pet food bags, aerosol cans, aluminum pans or foil, cords, strings, tape, chains, wires, window glass, mirrors, ceramics, china, drinking glasses, air pillows, clothing, towels & bedding, shower curtains, diapers.

Scrap metal has separate dumpster at Center– ask Site Attendant prior to disposal
Go to **PlasticFilmRecycling.org** for plastic film & wrap drop-off locations.

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED!!!!

Asphalt, asphalt shingles, concrete, plaster, drywall, carpet, flooring, wood, bricks or rocks, compost, garden waste, brush, wood, stumps, medical waste, sharps (needles, lancets, syringes), pet waste, dead animals, asbestos, ballasts, capacitors, tires, waste oil, cars or other vehicles, car engines, tires, refrigerators, freezers, dehumidifiers, air conditioners, dishwashers, mattresses or box springs, furniture, light bulbs, batteries, paint cans, computers and all computer components, TV's or electronics, any item containing mercury, and any other materials considered hazardous waste by the EPA.

No loose ashes accepted – must be in tied plastic bag – burning barrels containing loose ash will not be accepted.
